As the new President and Chief Executive Officer, I am delighted to be presenting this Annual Report to you with Kathleen Savesky, our new board chair.

We both have long histories with IFAW and we are proud to be stepping up to take the helm at a time when our prior leadership, our supporters and staff around the world have built IFAW into a powerhouse that makes meaningful differences to the lives of animals.

None of us can do this alone. IFAW is determined to work with others—governments, other non-profit organizations, individuals, communities and corporations—to transform societies and build a world where animals are respected and protected.

We have been busy over the past 12 months:

- In an unprecedented year for dolphin strandings on Cape Cod, our Marine Mammal Rescue and Research team was able to rescue a remarkable 75 percent of live dolphins stranded over a record-setting 85-day stranding event.
- At great personal risk, a team from our office in France traveled to Cameroon to help save elephants that were being killed by the hundreds.

- IFAW joined with INTERPOL in an operation that targeted the illegal elephant ivory trade across 14 countries in Africa and made 214 arrests and recovered two tons of ivory.
- Our Beijing office raised the alarm about an impending illegal auction of 400 bottles of tiger bone wine leading authorities to block the auction and other auctions of endangered species in China.

However, we still have much to do. And it is the unwavering backing of our donors that makes us certain we can achieve the transformational change we seek. Together, we really are making a difference for animals. Thank you for your continued support.

Smashing the links in the ivory supply chain

IFAW is working to cut the deadly and illegal ivory supply chain at all its major intersections by training rangers in anti-poaching techniques, collaborating with law enforcement authorities to arrest traffickers and reducing demand throughout the world on and offline, especially in China, one of the largest consumers of ivory and other wildlife products.



“Alarm bells rang in early January warning of the presence of the poachers, and were simply ignored. Only international pressure and damning criticism of the lack of action by Cameroon authorities finally forced a response.”

An IFAW INTERPOL operation takes down ivory traffickers

IFAW has partnered with INTERPOL since 2005, helping the international law enforcement organisation tackle illegal wildlife trafficking. In March and April of 2012, IFAW and INTERPOL executed Operation WORTHY, the largest-ever coordinated wildlife law enforcement operation targeting the illegal trade in elephant ivory and rhinoceros horn in Africa. Officials made 214 arrests and seized 2 tons of ivory, 44 pounds of rhino horn and 30 illegal firearms.

Training the first lines of defense against the ivory trade

IFAW funds, equips and trains customs officials, law enforcement, park rangers and others who are responsible for stemming the flow of illegal ivory not only in Africa, but also in the Middle East, a key transit point for trafficking. IFAW has trained more than 1,600 law enforcement officers, customs officials and anti-poaching rangers around the world. In this fiscal year, IFAW conducted trainings in countries such as Botswana, Djibouti, Iraq, Tanzania, Dubai, Republic of Congo and Bhutan.



Operation WORTHY has been to date the most wide-ranging operation coordinated by INTERPOL against the illegal ivory trade,

not just in terms of seizures and arrests, but also in targeting the criminal organisations making millions of dollars through the killing and destruction of wildlife and their habitat, and associated crimes such as murder, corruption and money laundering.

Reducing demand in China for illegal wildlife products

Taking action in China

Since establishing an office in Beijing in 1997, IFAW has been committed to reducing demand for illegal wildlife products in China, one of the world's largest markets for goods like ivory carvings and tiger bone wine.



Our Chinese staff's keen insight into Chinese society enables them to create locally relevant, effective campaigns designed to reduce the demand for illegal wildlife products. In 2012, IFAW advertisements—created to raise awareness of the illegal wildlife trade—were displayed in airports, railway and bus stations and 200 residential communities, reaching an estimated 42 million viewers.



“ Our monitoring of wildlife markets indicates that illegal wildlife products are increasingly sold as collectibles, at auctions and by specialty purveyors who tout wildlife products such as elephant ivory and rhino horn as “investments.” Based on our alert, the authorities successfully stopped 400 bottles of tiger bone wine from being auctioned.”

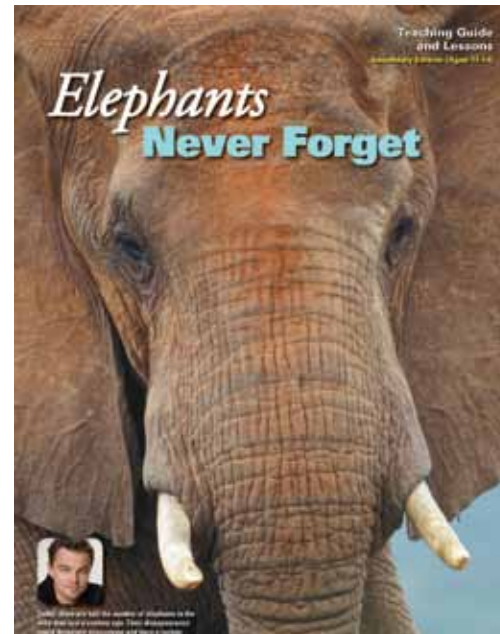

Collecting signatures for elephants

Nearly 290,000 people signed the Elephant March petition demanding their governments take action to save elephants from poaching and illegal ivory trade. Our staff in France, Germany, the Netherlands, United Kingdom and other European Union countries; Australia and the United States prepared to turn the signatures over to their government officials.



Leonardo DiCaprio kicks off elephant conservation campaign

Actor and environmentalist Leonardo DiCaprio helped launch IFAW's Elephants, Never Forget Animal Action Education week (3-9 October 2011) and education programme. Each year, 5 million students, parents and educators participate in the Animal Action Education programme.

Racing to protect marine mammals

A major victory in the campaign to end sealing

Everyone who has fought so hard alongside IFAW to protect seals had reason to celebrate in December when the Customs Union of Belarus, Kazakhstan and the Russian Federation banned the import and export of harp seal skins. It's the biggest victory in the campaign to end commercial sealing since the

European Union banned non-Inuit seal products in 2009. The future looks bleaker than ever for the dying Canadian sealing industry.



Remarkable success for marine mammal rescue and research

IFAW's Marine Mammal Rescue and Research team responded to an unprecedented number of common dolphin strandings on Cape Cod. Over an 85-day period, MMRR investigated a record 216 cases of stranded dolphins. Of 98 stranded alive, the team rescued 74 percent and returned them to the ocean. This remarkable success rate is the highest yet achieved by MMRR.



Saving the endangered right whale from ship strikes

IFAW, in collaboration with government, academia, private industry and other partners, launched *Whale Alert*, a free Apple iPad/iPhone application that alerts mariners when right whales are nearby so they can take action to avoid them.

North Atlantic right whales, which live along North America's east coast from Newfoundland to Florida, are one of the world's rarest large animals and a species

on the brink of extinction. The deadliest threats these gentle creatures face is collisions with large commercial vessels and entanglement in outmoded fishing gear.

Meet us, don't eat us

Summertime visitors to Iceland were greeted by a high-profile campaign sponsored by IFAW

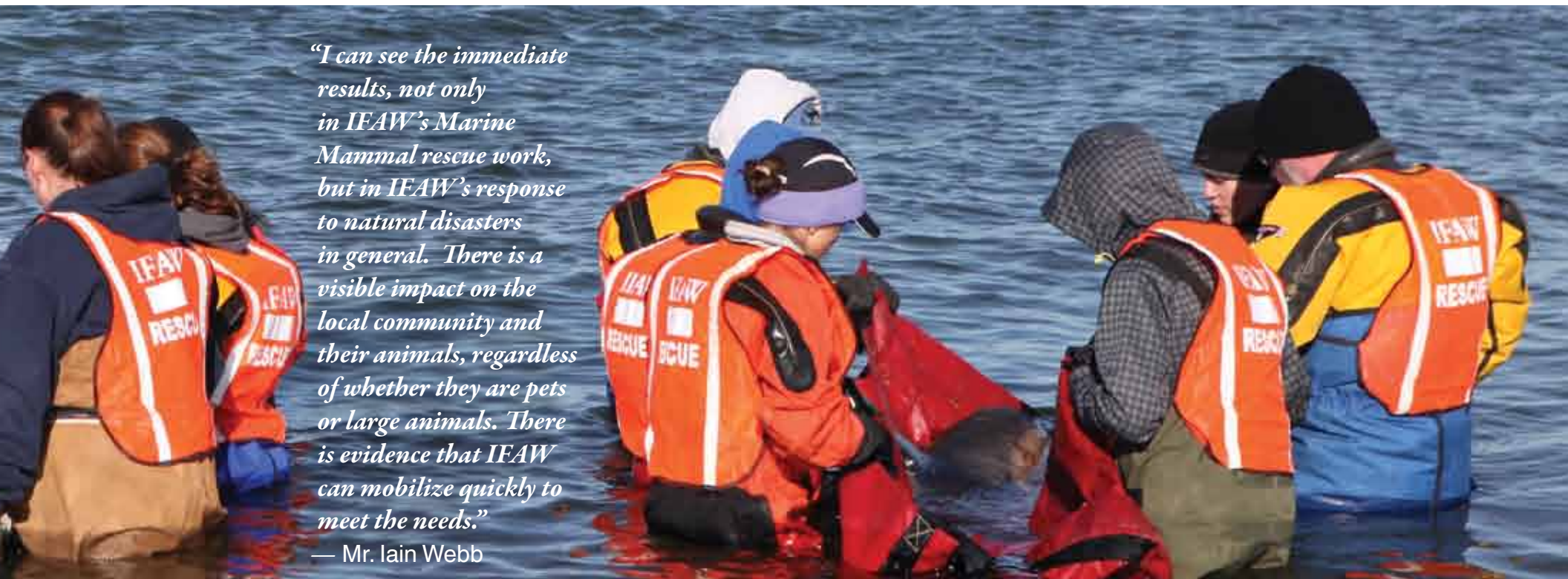
and the Icelandic Whale Watching Association that encouraged them to enjoy responsible whale watching and to avoid sampling whale meat. The campaign, "Meet Us Don't Eat Us" was intended to dispel the belief some tourists have that whale meat is a popular dish enjoyed by Icelanders. However, according to a 2010 Gallup poll, only about 5 percent of Icelanders say they eat whale meat regularly.

Song of the Whale sets sail for whales

Song of the Whale, IFAW's specially designed, non-invasive research vessel, participated in one of the most comprehensive whale studies in the world—conducting critical research around Stellwagen Bank to help save whales from collisions with ships and entanglement in fishing gear off the coast of Massachusetts.

Rescuing and protecting animals in crisis

Helping dogs and cats in South Africa

IFAW's Community-Led Animal Welfare project provides much-needed, free veterinary treatment and pet care to impoverished townships in and around Johannesburg and

Khayelitsha, South Africa. These disadvantaged communities lack access to any form of health care for their dogs and cats. IFAW provides spaying/neutering and basic veterinary care and extensive community outreach and education about humane pet care. This fiscal year, CLAW treated 21,100 companion animals in Johannesburg and 9,704 in Khayelitsha.



Hope for dogs and cats in a Balinese community

IFAW and its partner, Bali Animal Welfare Association, managed a comprehensive programme to help Balinese communities provide better care for their cats and dogs. IFAW and BAWA held regular community meetings and provided medication and food. Vaccinations kept puppies safe from diseases such as parvo and distemper, and protected villagers and dogs from rabies. Nearly 2,950 dogs received direct care in the fiscal year.

Feeding starving animals in Pakistan and India

After heavy monsoon rains battered South Asia for weeks, causing widespread flooding and displacing millions of people and animals, IFAW initiated relief operations in southern Pakistan and eastern India, two areas that bore the brunt of the incessant rains. IFAW raced to get food to farm animals in the hardest-hit areas as fast as possible, providing feed for 4,559 animals.

Eight bear cubs find a new home in the wild

The IFAW Bear Rescue Centre in Bubonitsy, northeast of Moscow, rescued eight bear cubs and released eight this year, bringing the number of bears rescued since 1995 to 184. The centre raised awareness of the plight of bears left orphaned by the “winter den hunt”—the cruel practice of rousing hibernating bears from their dens and shooting them, which left many tiny bears cubs orphaned so that they starved or froze to death. The practice is now outlawed thanks

to “Rules of the Hunt,” legislation passed in March 2011. IFAW gathered 400,000 signatures supporting the legislation.



Raptor wildlife rescue centre celebrates 10 Years

Government officials, conservationists, animal rescuers and celebrities marked the 10-year anniversary of the Beijing Raptor Rescue Centre—China’s only raptor rescue and rehabilitation facility. Of more than 3,300 birds taken in at BRRC over 10 years, 54 percent were rehabilitated and released.



IFAW financial overview, global

The steadfast generosity of IFAW's supporters continued to make a positive difference during fiscal year 2012, affording the organisation the capacity to successfully carry out our mission to rescue, rehabilitate and protect animals and their habitats around the world. Revenues and expenses remained constant, with our investment portfolio showing modest changes over fiscal year 2011. IFAW's balance sheet remains strong and stable. We are well placed to continue our critical work to help animals in the years ahead.

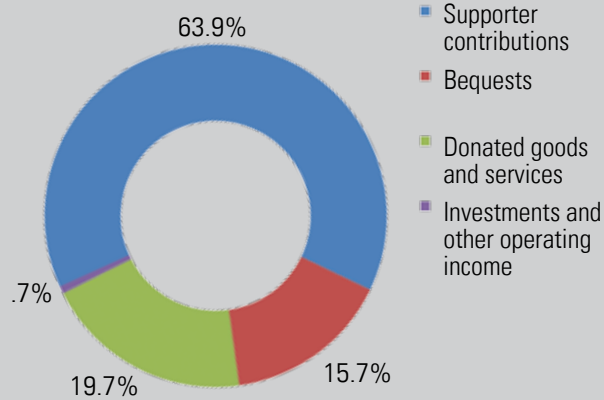

Programme accomplishments in the United Kingdom



Song of the Whale investigates porpoises in the North Sea

Our crew on *Song of the Whale*, a research vessel specially designed for the study of marine mammals, spent 20 days investigating the distribution of harbour porpoises in UK, Dutch and German waters. The area is a candidate for marine protected area status. More research is needed to establish current trends in porpoise distribution and to provide baseline data for reducing activities in the area that may disturb the porpoises' natural behaviour and movement.

The fight to protect the ban on hunting with dogs

Since the Hunting Act banning the cruel sport of hunting with dogs came into force in February 2005, IFAW has focused on ensuring the ban is enforced with its team of hunt monitors continuing to gather evidence of law breaking.

Following intensive lobbying from the Countryside Alliance, who represent hunting interests, the UK's coalition Government promised politicians a free vote on whether to vote on the repeal of the Hunting Act.

IFAW has worked closely with other anti-hunting organisations to mobilise our supporters to lobby their Members of Parliament to keep the hunt ban. This approach has been very successful with more MPs supporting the ban than those saying they would vote for repeal.

An Animal Action Education programme for young people

For 20 years, IFAW has sponsored Animal Action Education, our signature education programme designed to give young people the knowledge and tools they need to take positive action on

behalf of animals and the environment. In FY2012, approximately 5 million educators, students and their families worldwide took part in the programme.

This year, IFAW's Animal Action Education theme was "Elephants, Never Forget", a programme that highlights the plight of elephants and the challenges this mighty and iconic species faces for survival.



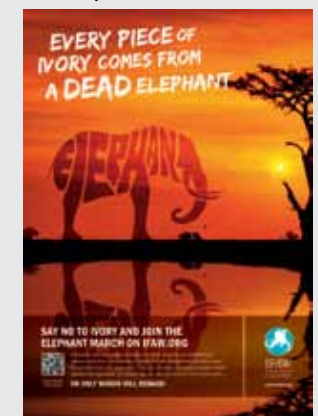
The Animal Action Education programme ran in 16 countries: Australia, Belgium, Bhutan, Canada, China, Kenya, France, Germany, India, Nepal, United Arab Emirates, Netherlands, Russia, South Africa, UK and U.S.

In the UK and Ireland, about 40,000 students from 2,000 schools participated in the programme.
